ARTICLE VI

Division 2. Emergency Police/Fire Services Fees Collection

Section 2-262 (b) Liability for expenses of an emergency response.

1. Motor Vehicle Fee. A charge of \$250.00 per hour for each Township-owned emergency motor vehicle used in providing an emergency service. In the event that the total number of hours spent in providing an emergency service does not exceed one, then, in that event, the total of fees for Township-owned motor vehicles used in providing such emergency service shall not exceed \$250.00.
2. Personnel Fee. A charge of \$20.00 per hour for each firefighter and \$20.00 per hour for each police officer involved in providing an emergency service.
3. Other Fees. Other fees shall include: the actual costs of any disposable supplies and materials used in providing an emergency service; the actual costs of renting or leasing any special equipment used in providing an emergency service; the replacement cost of any Township-owned supplies and equipment damaged, lost or destroyed in providing an emergency service; the actual costs of any special consulting and technical service and/or laboratory costs incurred in providing an emergency service; the actual costs of any specialized services used in providing an emergency service; and, any actual costs incurred in preparing for, or evaluating an event subject to this Ordinance.
4. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this subsection, the total of all of the charges for any residential fire shall not exceed \$500.00.
5. Exemption. Emergency services provided for Township-owned property shall be exempt from all of the charges authorized in this subsection.
