K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 10:09 a.m.

Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by G. Rowley, to approve the June 24, 2019 committee minutes as presented. Motion carried – All in favor.

Discussion took place regarding the bid from the Road Commission for the next 5 roads on our improvement plan. The total cost came back at \$367,620, however, the Township only has \$270,000 in the budget for roads this year. At the recommendation of the Road Commission, improvements on Bay Road and River Trail could be pushed back. That would mean Revilo, Coventry, and Hidden Roads could be fixed at an estimate of \$210,408. As long as the actual bids come back close to the estimates, the Township may have enough to chip and seal a few roads – specifically looking at Schumann and Christiana. Patches on Glennbrook and State Street Road could also be considered. Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by G. Rowley, to recommend to the Township Board to request bids on Revilo, Coventry, and Hidden Roads and following up on costs for some chip and seal or patching if the budget allows. Motion carried – All in favor.

Discussion took place on the Rose Court Catch Basin issue. Further investigation is needed before making a recommendation to the Township Board.

The sewer near Euclid and North Union is failing again. Last summer it was flushed with the hopes that it would resolve the issue. It is now backing up again and may need to be repaired or replaced. Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by G. Rowley, to recommend to the Township Board to request an estimate for sewer repair from Fleis & VandenBrink. Motion carried – All in favor.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 10:24 a.m.
