Public Works Committee
March 14, 2023

PRESENT: Karie Wardynski, Glenn Rowley, and Diane Yaworski

K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by D. Yaworski, to approve the November 18, 2022, committee minutes as presented. Motion carried – All in favor.

The committee discussed the 2023 Road Project Estimates provided by the Road Commission. The estimate for Frost and Handy Drives were over budget for this year so we will look to reconsidering that in the next couple of years. G. Rowley presented the projects for Western Field Subdivision (approx. \$200,000), Sherwood Subdivision (approx. \$97,000), Bay Side Subdivision (approx. \$45,000), Donahue Beach (approx. \$36,000) and Smith Road (approx. \$25,000). The total of all five projects is \$432,817, which leaves a little cushion from our \$450,000 road budget. Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by D. Yaworski, to recommend requesting the Road Commission solicit bids for the 5 named road projects to the Township Board. Motion carried – All in favor.

The committee also discussed the Drinking Water Asset Management (DWAM) grant that we may be receiving this year to investigate the unknown water lines we have to determine if they are lead.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 5:39 p.m.
