Public Works Committee
April 26, 2021
9:00 a.m.**

PRESENT: Glenn Rowley, Karie Wardynski, Tim Banaszak

K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by T. Banaszak, to approve the March 5, 2021 committee minutes as presented. Motion carried – All in favor.

Discussion took place regarding the Road Repair Estimates received from the Road Commission. The Board has budgeted \$270,000 for the repair of River Trail, Bay Road, and Canterbury. The bids from the Road Commission, which include the Local Roads Contribution, are \$214,812 for those three projects. Another bid was received for Yorkshire in the amount of \$65,612.50. This would bring the total to \$280,424.50. Since we have also received the excise tax payment from marihuana facilities this year, the committee discussed using some of those funds to make up the difference. Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by T. Banaszak, to recommend accepting the bids from the Road Commission for River Trail, Bay Road, Canterbury, and Yorkshire, and using some of the excise tax funds to increase the budget. Motion carried – All in favor.

Streetlights were the next item discussed. There has been a formal request for a light at the corner of Lagoon Beach and Hendrie. There has also been interest, but no formal request for the corner of Bangor and Alderwood. G. Rowley brought up the corner of State Park and Lauria. The committee agreed that this would be another good location. Moved by T. Banaszak, supported by K. Wardynski, to approve a light at each of the three intersections – Lagoon Bach & Hendrie, Bangor & Alderwood, State Park & Lauria. Motion carried – All in favor.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 9:12 a.m.
