**Charter Township of Bangor
Public Works Committee
May 15, 2023
5:15 p.m.**

PRESENT: Karie Wardynski, Glenn Rowley, and Diane Yaworski

K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m.

Moved by G. Rowley, supported by D. Yaworski, to approve the March 14, 2023, committee minutes as amended. Motion carried – All in favor.

The committee discussed the 2023 Road Project Bids provided by the Road Commission. The bids for the projects for Western Field Subdivision, Sherwood Subdivision, Bay Side Subdivision, Donahue Beach and Smith Road came in about \$90,000 under budget. The total bid price for all five projects is \$337,126. The committee discussed approving slightly more in case projects go over budget as they have for the past few years. Moved by G. Rowley, supported by K. Wardynski, to recommend approving \$350,000 for the Road Commission bids for the 5 named road projects to the Township Board. Motion carried – All in favor.

The committee also discussed water meter replacement pricing. The original estimates provided to us for the cost per meter did not include the cellular data plan costs that would be required for each meter. The Water Department is looking into alternative meter models. G. Rowley will update the committee as pricing is worked out.

G. Rowley also provided a brief update on the Dow Dioxin Project and their requirement for the Township to take on the maintenance costs of the sewer lines running to the public restrooms by the light house. There has been an emergency meeting called with EGLE, Dow, and the DNR to discuss other options besides passing the burden on to the Township. The estimated annual maintenance cost is about \$15,000.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 5:25 p.m.
