K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by T. Banaszak, to approve the February 2, 2022, committee minutes as presented. Motion carried – All in favor.

The DWS sent an agreement for chip and seal work on N. Chilson, Fletcher, N Erie, Oakwood, Schumann, Christiana, Northview, Jean, and Barted Roads for a total of \$62,170. Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by T. Banaszak, to recommend approval of the Chip and Seal agreement for \$62,170 to the Township Board. Motion carried – All in favor.

The committee discussed an email from Tom Fitzgerald from the DWS regarding joint seal failures under Greenfield Drive and Greenfield Court. T. Fitzgerald is seeking approval from the board to initiate an investigation but does not currently have a cost estimate. Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by T. Banaszak, to recommend approval for the DWS to investigate the joint seals at a cost up to \$20,000. Motion carried – All in favor.

Discussion took place on some light poles that had been installed and some damage to the newly paved road on West Park done by the Waste Management Truck. T. Banaszak will drive over to inspect the damage.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 4:39 p.m.
