Public Works Committee
August 8, 2022

PRESENT: Karie Wardynski, Tim Banaszak, Glenn Rowley

K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m.

Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by T. Banaszak, to approve the June 7, 2022, committee minutes as presented. Motion carried – All in favor.

The committee discussed the sewer rehab under Greenfield Drive and Greenfield Court. The Department of Water and Sewer recommended Inliner Solutions at a cost of \$72,215. Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by T. Banaszak, to recommend Inliner Solutions to the Board for the project. Motion carried – All in favor.

Discussion took place on DWS meter replacement estimates. The current estimate for Bangor Township for Water and Sewer meter replacement is \$2.1 million. This could be broken up over a 5 year period. The meters would all be cellular which would eliminate the need for staff to go out to do readings, but would require a cellular service agreement. These are just preliminary estimates and may change. The committee discussed the possible need for building the cost into water and sewer bill charges until the project is complete.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 3:10 p.m.
