PRESENT: Karie Wardynski, Glenn Rowley, and DPW Representatives Keri Christian and Cyndi Hammond

K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 3:32 p.m.

Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by G. Rowley, to approve the August 8, 2022, committee minutes as presented. Motion carried – All in favor.

The committee discussed the increased wholesale water and sewer rates as well as the status of the funds at the water department. The sewer fund was exactly where we wanted with the projects coming up in our infrastructure plan. Our water fund was beginning to dip a little below target due to the unexpected pump station rehab. It is not in danger of running out, but ideally should be brought up a bit. Since the sewer fund was already on target with current rates, the committee discussed leaving that cost as is, and focusing on the water rate increase this year. Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by Glenn Rowley, to recommend an increase of \$0.45 to the water rate to the Township Board. Motion carried – All in favor.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 3:43 p.m.
