PRESENT: Karie Wardynski, Tim Banaszak, Cyndi Hammond and Keri Christian from the DWS

K. Wardynski called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by T. Banaszak, to approve the April 26, 2021, committee minutes as presented. Motion carried – All in favor.

Discussion took place regarding the 2022 Water and Sewer Rates. Keri presented the committee with a proposed budget with current rates and the deficits that would occur without rate increases. After discussion on how Bangor compares to other municipalities – in the lower half – a consensus was reached for new rates. Moved by K. Wardynski, supported by T. Banaszak, to recommend a rate increase of \$0.15 for water and \$0.10 for sewer to the Township Board. Motion carried – All in favor.

An email from Bill Bohlen was reviewed on the costs to fix manholes after paving Midland Road. The cost presented to the Township was \$4,500 for 5 manhole repairs, as a worst case scenario. Moved by T. Banaszak, supported by K. Wardynski, to recommend a cost not to exceed \$4,500 for manhole adjustments contingent on further discussion with DWS. Motion carried – All in favor.

Being no further business, the Department of Public Works Committee Meeting adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
