The **Special Meeting** of the Bangor Township Board of Trustees was called to order by Supervisor Rowley at 5:00 p.m. for a Trash Special Assessment Public Hearing.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Hearing on the Trash collection Special Assessment roll began at 5:01 p.m.

- Clerk Bublitz stated a letter was received from Sandy Braendle, 4602 SW Lewis Drive, who suggested a reduced rate for limited income homeowners and/or senior citizens.
- Richard Talbot, 4603 E. Lewis Drive, was in the audience and spoke neither in favor nor against, simply stating he felt as a resident he should attend.
- Supervisor Rowley and Treasurer Wardynski stated numerous phone calls were received regarding the increase, who bid for the service and generalized questions.
- Jill Reynolds, Waste Management, addressed the board on how the roll out would happen and answered questions about homeowners who already lease bins. She stated once the new bins are delivered and the old bins picked up, refunds would be issued to those who have already paid in advance.
- The roll out of the new trash bins will be during the same time the new recycle bins are being delivered.
- Trustee Yaworski asked if they will be replacing old bins. Per Jill it will be case by case basis for replacing them - if they are old and cracked they will get a new one; however, if the homeowner has a newer bin Waste Management will not replace, but homeowners would not be billed any longer for their existing bin.
- Waste Management will be mailing information to all homeowners and literature will be handed out with the new bins.

Public Hearing ended at 5:11 p.m.
