ORDINANCE #302 STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ADOPTION

An ordinance authorizing the Township to assume responsibility for administration and enforcement of the State Construction Code Act, 1972 P.A. 230, as amended, within its political boundaries.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF BANGOR, BAY COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the Bangor Township Construction Code Ordinance.

SECTION 2. RESPONSIBILITY. The Charter Township of Bangor, Bay County, Michigan, assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of the State Construction Code Act, 1972 P.A. 230, as amended, within its political boundaries in accordance with SECTION 8b.(1) of the Act. The officers designated to enforce provisions of the Act are the Township Supervisor, Zoning Administrator, Building Inspector, Electrical Inspector, Plumbing Inspector and Mechanical Inspector.

SECTION 3. REPEALS. All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERANCE. Should any part of this ordinance or of the Act be declared unconstitutional, illegal, or of no force and effect by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall not be deemed to affect the validity of any other part or portion.

SECTION 5. PUBLICATION. This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with provisions of the Act governing same.

SECTION 6. RATIFICATION. The Bangor Township Board hereby ratifies and confirms the validity of the actions of any of the enforcement officers identified in Section 2, above, relating to administration or enforcement of any of the provisions of the State Construction Code prior to the effective date of this ordinance.
