General: Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Mechanical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much notice as possible. The inspector will need the **job location** and **permit number.**

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of si months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CON DUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELED PERMIT CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
