M. Galloner called the meeting to order at 4:33 pm

Motion to approve the minutes from November 30, 2023 as presented made by T. Banaszak, supported by M. Galloner, motion carried unanimously.

Discussion about tour of Monitor Township Fire Department.

- M. Galloner mentioned Thomas Township Fire Department is wrapping up a new station, is going to see if we can coordinate a tour.
- M. Sarnowski, suggesting double-up two to a bedroom but nobody would share at the same time, would use on different shifts.
- M. Galloner, need ample bathrooms, have one located off apparatus bay
- M. Galloner, at the captain's meeting this morning he requested captains to have their guys give them their *needs* now, can discuss *wants* later.
- M. Sarnowski, recommends the bays be long enough to house the trucks if there is an issue at station 7 and trucks need to be housed temporarily, over storing outside. Need to measure the lot to see what we can accommodate. Would be ideal to have bays be 18' wide.
- T. Banaszak, would trucks enter station off Euclid, plan right now is to enter off Columbian and pull out onto Euclid.
- T. Banaszak, plumbing would be above each bay, would prevent freezing.
- M. Sarnowski, recommended drains that run the full length of each bay, doesn't see the need for a wash bay, M. Galloner mentioned it would help keep each bay clean to have a specified wash bay.
- T. Banaszak, we need to look into green energy and possible grant opportunities.
- M. Sarnowski, architect should be able to help with ADA requirements; work-out room should have a roll-up door to make moving equipment easier; would like to see the cement dedication block from the MSP post incorporated into a new building; geothermal heat would be beneficial.
