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Mobile Home Park Site (from #15):

- 1. When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a person must include the application fee (refer to #1) and a feeder (refer to #14). This shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor.
- 2. When setting a HUD mobile home or a pre-manufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee (refer to #1), service (refer to #3) and feeder (refer to #14).
- 3. When installing a site service in a park, the permit application must include the application fee (refer to #1), service (refer to #3), plus the number of park sites (refer to #15).

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed. All installations shall be in conformance with the Electrical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much notice as possible. The inspector will need the job location and permit number.

Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing, and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
