

**ORDINANCE #323**  
**ADDRESSING FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT PROVISION**  
**OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE**

Adopted: 09/14/10  
Effective: 09/23/10

An ordinance amendment to affirm an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Charter Township of Bangor located in Bay County, and to designate regulated flood hazard areas under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, Act No. 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

**The Charter Township of Bangor ordains:**

**SECTION 1. AGENCY DESIGNATED.** Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, the Building Official of the Charter Township of Bangor is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibility of the Charter Township of Bangor under Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, State of Michigan. The Charter Township of Bangor assumes responsibility for the administration and enforcement of said Act throughout the corporate limits of the community adopting this ordinance. *(Amended by Ordinance #407, effective 6/19/24)*

**SECTION 2. CODE APPENDIX ENFORCED.** Pursuant to the provisions of the state construction code, in accordance with Section 8b(6) of Act 230, of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended, Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced by the enforcing agency within the Charter Township of Bangor. *(Amended by Ordinance #407, effective 6/19/24)*

**SECTION 3. DESIGNATION OF REGULATED FLOOD PRONE HAZARD AREAS.** The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Flood Insurance Study (FIS) Entitled “Flood Insurance Study for Bay County, Michigan (All jurisdictions)” and dated July 31, 2024 and the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) panels contained on index panel 26017CIND0B, effective July 31, 2024 are adopted by reference for the purposes of administration of the Michigan Construction Code, and declared to be a part of Section 1612.3 of the Michigan Building Code, and to provide the content of the “Flood hazards” section of Table R301.2(1) of the Michigan Residential Code. *(Amended by Ordinance #407, effective 6/19/24)*

**SECTION 4. REPEALS.** All ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5. PUBLICATION.** This ordinance shall be effective after legal publication and in accordance with the provisions of the Act governing same.
